Douglas, Elbert and Park Counties can be served by the Denver Area Committee or the Diocese of Colorado Springs Catholic Committee.

The Diocese of Pueblo Catholic Committee serves youth in Delta, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Mesa, Montrose, Ouray and San Miguel counties.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR EARNING MY RELIGIOUS EMBLEM?

1. Decide which emblem you can work on from the descriptions on the right.
2. Contact one of the following to help you get started: your troop leader, parish priest, emblems counselor, the Catholic Committee on Scouting and Camp Fire (CCSCF), the local Girl Scout Office, or Camp Fire of Colorado, Inc. (Please see the website for the phone numbers and emails you need.)
3. Order the appropriate workbook using the attached order form.
4. When all the requirements have been completed for the award on which you have been working, complete the application in the back of the workbook or project book (be sure to get all the required signatures) and send it along with your order to purchase the medal to the CCSCF (address on back of order form). If working as a group each participant should submit an application.
5. Contact your parish priest to make arrangements to have the emblem presented at an appropriate liturgical ceremony in your parish. You will also be recognized with a certificate at a Catholic Recognition ceremony.
6. All emblem recipients will be invited to an annual Recognition Ceremony and Mass typically held after Easter of each year. Check the web site for more information.

WHICH CATHOLIC RELIGIOUS EMBLEMS CAN I EARN?

FAMILY OF GOD AWARD

Brownie (Girl Scouts); Starlight (Camp Fire)

Family of God is the Christian-family program for youth in the 2nd or 3rd grade (age 7-9) to help you develop as a member of your family and parish and to discover the presence of God in your daily life. You will work with your parents and an advisor.

I LIVE MY FAITH AWARD

Junior (Girl Scouts); Adventure (Camp Fire)

I Live My Faith is the emblem for youth who are 9-11 years old and will help you appreciate more deeply the place of God and religion in your life. You will work with your parents and an advisor.

MARIAN AWARD

Cadette & Senior (Girl Scouts); Discovery (CF)

The Marian Medal is a program for youth that are 12-15 years of age and helps you understand Mary as a model of openness and spiritualism, a woman of the Church. You will work in a group with a counselor in your parish.

THE SPIRIT ALIVE AWARD

Senior to age 18 (Girl Scouts); Horizon (CF)

The Spirit Alive Medal is a program for Senior/ Horizon age youth and is designed to help you in discovering how the Holy Spirit moves within your life, calling you to a greater participation in the ministry of the Church. You can work alone or with a group and a counselor or advisor.
