- For Ad Altare Dei and Pope Pius XII contact **Mark Schultz** at 303-883-2435 to set a date for a progress review. When the review has been completed satisfactorily, you will be asked to pay the appropriate fees. Emblems Counselor will award emblems.

The purpose of this committee is to assist young men and women to obtain their appropriate Catholic Religious Emblems.

There are two sub-committees that serve the Archdiocese of Denver. Each sub-committee serves either the Denver Area Council BSA or the Longs Peak Council BSA.

- The **Denver Area Catholic Committee** serves Catholic scouts in the **Denver Area Council**; generally the parish is in Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Clear Creek, Denver, Gilpin, Grand, Jefferson and Summit Counties.
- The **Northern Colorado Catholic Committee** serves **Longs Peak Council** scouts' parishes in Boulder, Jackson, Larimer, Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Sedgwick, Washington, Weld and Yuma Counties.

The **Diocese of Colorado Springs Catholic Committee** serves **Denver Area Council** scouts in Douglas, Elbert and Park Counties.

The **Diocese of Pueblo Catholic Committee** serves youth in Delta, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Mesa, Montrose, Ouray and San Miguel counties.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR EARNING MY RELIGIOUS AWARD?

1. Decide which award you can work on from the descriptions on the right.
2. Contact one of the following to help you get started: your unit leader, parish priest, emblems counselor, the Denver Catholic Committee on Scouting and Camp Fire, or the local Boy Scout Office. (Please see the website for the phone numbers and eMail addresses you will need.)
3. Purchase the appropriate workbook from your local BSA supply shop.
4. If you are working on your **AD ALTARE DEI** or **POPE PIUS XII**, you will need an emblems counselor. If you do not have a counselor, call the Emblems Committee Chair in your council for counselors in your area.

If you are working on your **LIGHT OF CHRIST** and **PARVULI DEI** award, your parent or guardian will serve as your emblems counselor.

5. When all the requirements have been completed for the award on which you have been working, complete the application in the back of the workbook or project book (**be sure to get all the required signatures**) follow the process for your council described later. If working as a group each participant should submit an application.
6. Scouts should contact your parish priest to make arrangements to have the emblem presented at an appropriate liturgical ceremony in your parish. Each emblem recipient and their family will be invited to an annual recognition ceremony held in the Spring of each year. Check our web site for dates and details.
7. Only catholic youth registered with the BSA may earn these emblems.

WHICH CATHOLIC RELIGIOUS AWARD CAN I EARN?

LIGHT OF CHRIST

Light of Christ is a family program for Catholic Tiger Cubs and Wolf Cub Scouts in the 1st and 2nd grades. They can get help from your pack or parish coordinator. As you complete each requirement your parents will sign off in your workbook.

PARVULI DEI

Parvuli Dei is also a family program for any Bear Cub or Webelos Scout of the Catholic faith. Your parents will sign-off in your workbook as you complete the requirements. They can get the pack or parish coordinator to help if they have questions.

AD ALTARE DEI

Ad Altare Dei is a program for Boy Scouts. It is primarily aimed at Boy Scouts in grades 7 through 8, but older Scouts & male Venturers are invited to earn the award. You will work in a group with a counselor who will help you to understand the requirements and will sign-off as you complete the requirements.

POPE PIUS XII

Pope Pius XII is for high school aged Boy Scouts or Venturers (boys and girls). Scouts and male Venturers are encouraged to earn the Ad Altare Dei first (but it is not required). You will work with a group to earn this medal. The counselor will serve as a monitor or discussion leader.
